The Skulduggery Pleasant series is a series of books written by Derek Landy, with eleven main books in total and two spin-off books. Originally, the books of the first series were released every April, but Skulduggery Pleasant: Mortal Coil was released in September and since then the books have been released in late August or early September. The last installment of the first series was released in August 2014, and a second series that began with new books beginning an annual release from June 2017. The series is illustrated by Tom Percival. When the new papers were released, they came with several bonus short stories all set a few months after the storyline of each book. They also came with new covers. The short stories were later removed and published in a collection in July 2014. Derek also began writing a number of feature-length novellas, starting with The End of the World in February 2012. The Maleficent Seven, starring Tanieth Low, was released in March 2013. Armageddon-Outta-Here, a collection of each previously published short story and new content, was published on July 3, 2014. It also included a short story that manifested in a full-length novel: Get You Behind Me, Bubba Moon. Derek's second series is Demon Road. The first book in the series was released in 2015. The following are seven of the back deck (without text) for the new paperbacks. The last three covers are US-exclusive editions, also drawn by Tom Percival. Trivia The books are divided into four trilogies: The Faceless Ones Trilogy, the Necromancers Trilogy, the Darquesse Trilogy and the Abyssinia Trilogy. Each book has a theme. (eg. Sciene Fiction, Super-Hero, War, etc.) Playing with fire is the only book to end with a battle about to begin. Start. Days are the only book to open from the antagonist's point of view, excluding the prologue for Last Stand of Dead Men. Dark days and mortal flushes are the only books released within the same year (2010). However, the novellas were released in the years 2012 - 2014 a few months before the main books were. Death Bringer is the first book in the series to have a prologue. As the book series progresses, each book expands for a long time, with each having approx. 1000. The difference between the first book and the fifth is ten chapters. It's similar to the Harry Potter series, where each book's length of 1-5 has increased. As for individual words, Last State of Dead Men was the longest. The Maleficent Seven is one-third length of the first book. The Australian, New Zealand and Spanish versions of the books have changed their book height every trilogy. The original cover of each Skulduggery Pleasant book has the main protagonist(s) on the cover and the antagonist on the back page. The first book had a protagonist on both the front and back pages. The paperbacks had Skulduggery on the cover and Valkyrie (and/or Darquesse) on the back. The 2017 papers had a variety of characters on the front and no artwork on the back. All main books in the series depict Skulduggery holding fire except for Mortal Coil, Kingdom of the Wicked, Last Stand of Dead Men and The Dying Of The Light (though fire is present in the background). The Faceless Ones and Necromancer trilogies end with a large cliffhanger. Each main book except the first, the second, the fifth and the ninth end with a cliffhanger. The Maleficent Seven finishes with a number of unresolved plot points. Kingdom of the Wicked is the only book in the series to have an epiloes. While Last State of Dead Men does not have a designated prologue, it has two chapters set before the events of the book. While not an epilog, it has two chapters dealing with the immediate events after the War, leading to The Dying of the Light. Each main book from Death Bringer has a quote after the prologue. Armageddon-Outta-Here contains every Short Story ever printed, along with a new novella, three new short stories and a chapter from The Dying of the Light. It also contains a new timeline with updated setting dates for the short stories (See above). The books revolve around the adventures of the skeleton detective, Skulduggery Pleasant, his protégé, Valkyrie Cain, with other friends. The central story arc worries Valkyrie's struggle to stop evil forces threatening the world and her internal struggle to resist the darkness inside. Since the release of the first novel in 2007, Skulduggery Pleasant, the series has been praised by both readers and critics. The following novels were released every year afterwards, with the exception of the fourth and fifth novels, Dark Days and Mortal Coil, both of which were released in 2010. Landy was initially contracted to write three books, with any further books depending on how well the first trilogy was sold. The success of the first novels ensured the deal was extended first to six books and in 2011 HarperCollins signed the deal for the final trilogy. [1] In July 2016, Derek Landy announced via a video blog that although the Skulduggery Pleasant series was complete, the series as a whole is still set to continue with a sequel series, the first book of which was released on June 1, 2017, entitled Resurrection. [3] On April 2, 2020, Seasons of War, the fourth book in the second series, was released. [4] This is the beginning of the second (and final) trilogy of that series. In October 2020, the title for the 14th book was revealed. It will be titled Dead or Alive. Dead or Alive will come out in April 2021. The Maleficent Seven A novella with Tanith Low was published in 2013. The cover and title were released on 7 December 2012 after several delays. Landy said it was his favorite book cover ever. It was released on 28 March 2013 in the UK and Ireland and 1 April in some other countries. The novel follows Tanith Low and Billy-Ray Sanguine as they form a team of, outcasts and monsters to collect the God-killer weapons, so they may never be used against Darquesse, while Dexter Vex has recruited a team to collect the weapons with the exact opposite in mind: he wants to stock the weapons to be used against Darquesse. [28] Skulduggery Bite on March 20, 2020, Landy began posting a pick-your-adventure-type story on Twitter. It ended on April 1, 2020. [30] It made readers vote in a poll at the end of each day that he posted the tweets to decide something in the story. The story follows Valkyrie and Skulduggery going to America to examine a witch. It introduces the concept of Horts, essentially people outside the fictional universe who consume entertainment (it's actually real in the fictional world) and has choices about what's happening. Awards Skulduggery Pleasant won the Red House Children's Book Award,[31] the Bolton Children's Book Award[32] and the Staffordshire Young Teen Fiction Award. [33] The book was also recommended by the Richard & Judy Children's Book Club for confident readers (9+) in 2007. It also won the Portsmouth Book Awards in 2008, having been selected by schoolchildren in Portsmouth, as well as winning Irish book of the decade in 2010. In 2009 it also won the Kernow Youth and Grampian Book Awards by a majority vote.
